

can do to stay safe and still have fun on your bike!**

Here are some Bike Safety rules:
Give your head a break – always wear a helmet
when you ride your bike.



And wear it right. Don't push the helmet back
on your forehead - keep it level above your eyebrows.
And buckle the straps. The helmet should be snug.

**Keep your hands
on the handlebars of your bike.**



**And never, ever
give rides on your handlebars.**

**Always ride with a friend.
Be sensible. Never show off!**



See and be seen!



Make sure that you wear bright or light color clothing when you're riding so that drivers and other bicyclists can see you!

Watch OUT!



**Look out for potholes, cracks, railroad tracks,
wet leaves, and loose gravel.
Anything that could make you fall!**


Barkley's Bike Tips!

Ride in single file and watch out for people and animals. Use sidewalks if available or ride with traffic, close to the curb. Always use hand signals when turning or stopping and walk your bike across streets at the street corner.



Go with the flow.

The safe way is the RIGHT way. Always ride on the right ... in the same direction as vehicles.



Stick to bike paths and bike lanes. Learn the rules of the road and obey traffic laws. Look left, right and left again before crossing the street. Obey ALL traffic signs and signals.
